This includes regulations regarding foreign travel and research. Export controls and undue foreign influence guidelines can be found <a href="#">here</a> . Please review these, particularly related to foreign travel (including reporting any travel) and list of “at risk” <a href="#">countries</a> . <b>Please note:</b> No travel to these countries will be reimbursed using federal dollars.
