



Bulk Data Rule High-Level Decision Tree

[The DOJ Bulk Data Rule](#) prohibits or restricts U.S. entities from transferring or allowing bulk transfers of U.S.-related sensitive or government data to certain individuals and/or countries of concern.

Fully enforceable as of mid-2025, it mandates robust data governance and technical controls—failure of which risks severe civil and criminal penalties. Examples, applicable at various thresholds, include: personal identifiers (e.g., name, address), personal financial or health data, precise geolocation, biometrics, 'omic data, and genomic data.

The Bulk Data Rule applies even if the data to be shared has been de-identified, anonymized, pseudonymized, or encrypted.
